<u>Pandemic Update:</u> As the months have progressed, we have been following public health protocols for those attending the Divine Liturgy in person. Temperatures are taken prior to entering the church, masks must be worn inside the church, parishioners are seated 6' apart, hand sanitizer is available at multiple locations, books and prayer cards are not kept in the pews, separate spoons for Communion and the Meshe is placed in cups for the faithful. We open windows to introduce fresh air and will continue to do so during the winter months – so be sure to dress appropriately.

That being said there has been an increase in the number of Covid-19 cases reported in the Philadelphia area. Only come to church in person if you are comfortable doing so. Metropolitan Tikhon, (Locum Tenens of the Albanian Archdiocese) stated the following in a memo to Archdiocesan Clergy "It is important that you also emphasize that no one is forced or obliged to come to services, and that everyone should be extra vigilant in their personal activities during the week if they want to be able to come to church services."

Parish Council wants everyone to feel safe when they attend the Divine Liturgy in person. If you have any suggestion to improve our protocols please let us know. Parish Council will discuss the continuation of coffee hour at our December 2nd meeting, as the weather will soon prohibit us from gathering outside.
