Secretary's Report

Elena Shomos presented the minutes from the April 2020 meeting. We discussed Donna Dimitri's suggested revisions. All in favor of amendments.

Treasurer's Report

We reviewed the April Treasurer's report. Serge emailed the graphs and showed them on the Zoom call. Total pledges stand at \$32,814, we have received \$13,374. No one paid in April for icons. Pascha donations are currently \$4861. We also received additional funds from online sources. Expenses in the month of April included \$1700 worth of candles and Pascha supplies that can potentially be used at a later date. We have relatively few bills right now. - Possible that we can do a Sunday School event when we are back together to celebrate the end of the Sunday School year
- Hard to schedule for parents as everything is on Zoom

Technology Report

Given by Sergio Georgi. Topics covered included the following:

- Zoom events going well, events being posted to website
- Exploring option of live-streaming Divine Liturgy
 - Funding would be required for new equipment
 - Will depend on the complexity of the stream we want (from simple to recorded by someone with a camcorder)
 - Could go live as early as this Sunday, but we are looking at this as an option for when we are able to gather again
 - Parish Council was shown two different levels of equipment
 - A problem is that our church has poor connectivity with DSL
 - This may change once construction for the condos across the street starts. They have contracted with Comcast.
 - We could start with cellular streaming
 - Wes asked how the video will be encoded. More information about software needed is on the info page on Confluence.
- Motion was made by Fiori that Tech team (Sergio, Wes, Fiori) to spend up to \$5000 on equipment. Seconded by Elena Shomos.

Old Business

Elena reached out to Fr Brooks and he is open to a sendoff Postpone paint event due to lack of interest

New Business

Coffee hour with Fr Dennis has had a decent turnout. Steve proposed sending coffee out for coffee hour to our parishioners, with a letter inviting them to attend Zoom coffee hour. Charlie Biando's coffee company will provide 100 packages of coffee for \$6 per package including labor. Charlie will take care of mailing and packaging. In exchange we will send parishioners' email addresses to Charlie for promotion. Charlie may wish to sponsor coffee hours in the future by bringing in a pot of coffee. Steve motioned to spend \$840 for 120 packages of coffee to be sent and mailed to parishioners, seconded by Wesley Hanson. Motion accepted unanimously.

Reopening the church
