## Epistle: Acts of the Apostles 2:1-11 Gospel: John 7:37-52; 8:12

<u>The Feast of Holy Pentecost is</u> celebrated each year on the fiftieth day after the Great and Holy Feast of Pascha (Easter) and ten days after the Feast of the Ascension of Christ. The Feast is always celebrated on a Sunday.

The Feast commemorates the descent of the Holy Spirit upon the Apostles on the day of Pentecost, a feast of the Jewish tradition. It also celebrates the establishment of the Church through the preaching of the Apostles and the baptism of the thousands who on that day believed in the Gospel message of salvation through Jesus Christ. The Feast is also seen as the culmination of the revelation of the Holy Trinity.

**Parish Financial Update:** In an effort to keep our parishioners informed as to the state of our financial health, we will be including the monthly and year to date income and expenses for the parish in this Weekly Messenger, as well as in the first or second Messenger each month. Income includes pledges, memorial donations, fund raisers, candle and weekly basket donations. Expenses are much like the expenses in your home: gas, electric, insurance, cleaning, repairs and supplies. A major expense for the Church, which you do not have in your home, is the salary for our priest.

For the month of April our income was \$11,506.00 and our expenses were \$9,601.00 Year to date our income is \$54,815.00 - expenses \$50,475.00. As you can see we are doing ok as our income is greater than our expenses. Unfortunately, a portion of our income has been received in the form of memorial donations, which we receive as a result of the death of a parishioner. We are moving into the summer months, when, historically, our income decreases.
