Epistle: II Timothy 3:10-15 Gospel: Like 5:1-11

1st Sunday of Luke - Jesus Calls Fishermen: One day, Jesus was near a lake. A lot of people wanted to hear Him talking. They got so close to Him that it was hard to talk! He saw some fishermen who were done fishing for the day. He asked Simon, one of them, to take him out in his boat. Simon did, so Jesus could talk to all the people.
